tri.x partnered with the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham to provide information, resources and guidance to social workers



London Borough of Barking & Dagenham Adult Services implemented tri.x resources in July 2017, to help improve and support the Borough's Adult Services. At the time, as a result of various factors and service pressures, the information they were providing to staff was not always available in a timely way, easily located or routinely updated.

Through cross-service conversations, Adult Services knew that tri.x had already been effectively supporting the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham Children's Services with online procedures since October 2014. When Children's Services' colleagues told us that tri.x was developing a solution for Adult Services, they were keen to adopt it and got in touch with them before they had even finished the development!

"We are proud to be the first local authority to implement tri.x into our Adult Services."

Now, 4 years on staff all know about and use tri.x as part of their practice. Data analytics show us that the system is used consistently and around 500 times each month to provide information, resources and guidance to social workers and related practitioners across the Borough.



# Aims of the project



For the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham, the main aim while using tri.x is to ensure sure all the adult policies and information social workers require on a day-to-day basis are all in one easily accessible and secure area place.

The Borough also set out to achieve these aims:

- To enhance best practice across adult services in the Borough.
- To ensure the team were are up to date with the latest procedures and legislation.
- Develop a culture of confidence and a knowledgeable workforce.
- To reduce the risk of complaints and challenges.



# **Challenges**



The biggest challenge for London Borough of Barking & Dagenham has been embedding tri.x into everyone's practice.

### They told us:

"It can take time to spread the word and for practitioners to change how they access information, particularly if they are not IT confident or are very used to working in a certain way.

However, once practitioners know about tri.x and make time to explore it and familiarise themselves with how it works, they see the benefits."

#### They go on to say:

"tri.x helped us relaunched the site to staff in early 2021 through virtual sessions. Since this, our time usage has increased dramatically.

Analytics show that in 2023 there were around 1,500 users across the whole year. This year it is already at more than 3,000."



## **Evaluation**



One particular benefit the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham have found from using tri.x was the efficiency of accessing data. Since the COVID-19 pandemic, many Boroughs across the UK have moved away from paper and have turned to digital support. For the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham, tri.x has enabled the team to reflect any changes in local practice in real time and to deliver seamless services for adults.

tri.x has also supported the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham with access to networking opportunities and partnerships. Being connected with out people who use tri.x, the Borough have been able to maximise this to form beneficial contacts in the South of England.
